2015 Season

The 2015 season is shaping up to be a close contest for the Avon Tyres/TTC Group MSA British Hillclimb Championship. Alex Summer heads the table in his first year of sharing the Gould GR61X with 5 times champion Scott Moran but dropped scores come into play soon and Trevor Willis, Wallace Menzies and Moran are all closely matched behind him.

The annual trip to the Channel Islands was marred by the accident in Jersey to Jos Goodyear but he is making good progress in his recovery and we all wish him well. As a result round 20 was cancelled and only 27 rounds will count in the Championship.
